How to draw Yoyo

Use a pencil for the first steps and try to draw lightly so that you can erase the pencil at the end. Start with the biggest shapes and then add the details one by one.



Add the final lines with a pen by tracing the parts of your sketch that you want to keep. Erase the pencil lines you don't want, then fill in the details to finish your drawing. **Well done!**
